

靈修片語 你是否猶太人的君王?

你說的是。耶穌不單是猶太人的君王,更是普世的君王。 祂的王國是真理與生命、是神聖與恩寵、是公義、愛及和平的 王國。祂是一位好的、溫良的君王,祂照顧我們靈魂的安好。 祂因愛而來到世上,亦因愛而死亡。

耶穌明知等待祂的是出賣、離棄和十字架,而仍然前往耶路撒冷。耶穌騎在驢駒上來到耶路撒冷,為帶出一個和平的象徵及實現匝加利亞之預言(9:9)。祂以和順、謙卑之心來到聖城。祂戰勝罪惡,並給祂的子民帶來平安。

耶路撒冷人準備好迎接他們的救世君王。他們有些人把斗篷鋪在路上,其他的人把折下來的樹枝鋪撒在地上。前行後隨的群眾不斷地叫喊說:「賀三納於達味之子!因上主之名而來的,當受讚頌!賀三納於至高之天!」(瑪 21:9)但他們很少

Spiritual Corner Are You the King of the Jews?

You say so. Jesus is not only the King of the Jews but also the King of the world. His kingdom is a kingdom of truth and life, of holiness and grace, of justice, love and peace. A good king, a gentle king, who cares for the well-being of our souls. He came to this world out of love and he died out of love.

Jesus went to Jerusalem knowing full well what awaited him – betrayal, rejection, and crucifixion. Jesus arrived in Jerusalem astride a colt, a sign of peace and a fulfillment of the prophecy of Zechariah (9:9). He entered the Holy City in meekness and humility. He has come to offer victory over sin and peace to his people.

Rules for Fasting and Abstinence on Good Friday

Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Good Friday. The law of fasting binds those who have attained their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year. Traditionally, abstinence forbids the use of meat of warm blooded animals. Fasting includes abstinence and taking only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal. The sick, the weak and the pregnant are not bound by the law of abstinence and fasting.
