Position Overview

The Liturgy of the Word with Children Helper assists with presenting Liturgy of the Word with Children. Liturgy of the Word with Children is suitably adapted to be relevant to the lives and experiences of young children preparing them for full participation in the Liturgy. It gives them an opportunity to receive and respond to the Sunday readings.

Activities/Responsibilities

- Assist in the physical set up and take down of chairs and tables used for Liturgy of the Word with Children
- Assist in the set-up of materials required for each celebration and returning materials to their proper storage area at the end of the lesson
- Be present to assist the leaders as required during all scheduled celebrations
- Actively participate in the liturgy, helping children to worship, hear the proclamation, and share what they learn
- Under the direction of the Liturgy of the Word with Children Leader, assist with activities provided during Liturgy of the Word with Children

Screening Requirements

This is a High Risk/Position of Trust.

Before volunteering begins:

- Complete a Volunteer Application Form
- Attend interview and have personal references checked
- Complete a Police Information Check
- Complete appropriate training and orientation

After volunteering begins:

- There will be supervision and periodic evaluations
- An annual Offence Declaration and a new Police Information Check every 5 years
- Participant follow-ups may be conducted

Orientation and Training

Standard parish orientation program

- For volunteers over 16 years old, include AODA training
- For volunteers under 16 years old, highlight the importance of acting courteously and respectfully with those whom they interact and volunteer with, especially those with differences and disabilities

Participant Group

Children and youth who participate in the Liturgy of the Word with Children.

Support, Supervision and Evaluation



The Liturgy of the Word with Children Leader is the first level of support, supervision and evaluation. The Liturgy of the Word with Children Coordinator also exercises this role in his/her work.

Length of Ministry Appointment

One (1) year term with the ability to renew.
